

RESEARCH AWARDS TO DRS

The Dance Research Studio is pleased to announce that it has received funding awards from both The Sasakawa Foundation and The Daiwa Anglo-Japanese Foundation to support Artistic Director and Choreographer Jacky Lansley to make a research visit to Japan in March-May 2010.

The research is towards the development of interdisciplinary and intercultural performance training and practice and will have the following important outcomes which will be realised in phases through 2010/11

- The development of a new training module which will be integrated into the CPD programme **The Speaking Dancer: Interdisciplinary Performance Training 2011/2012** directed by Jacky Lansley based at the Dance Research Studio, London in partnership with the **University of Plymouth**.
- Contribute to the development of the **Dance Research Studio** as an international centre for performance research and a context for Japanese/UK links between performance practitioners, researchers and students.
- Provide a research opportunity for Jacky Lansley towards the development of future live and film projects with interdisciplinary performers.
- DRS will create an online data base of all Japanese/UK practitioners and students involved in the project towards a lasting network and context for exchange between UK and Japanese interdisciplinary performance practitioners.
